Depart by 7.45 am.

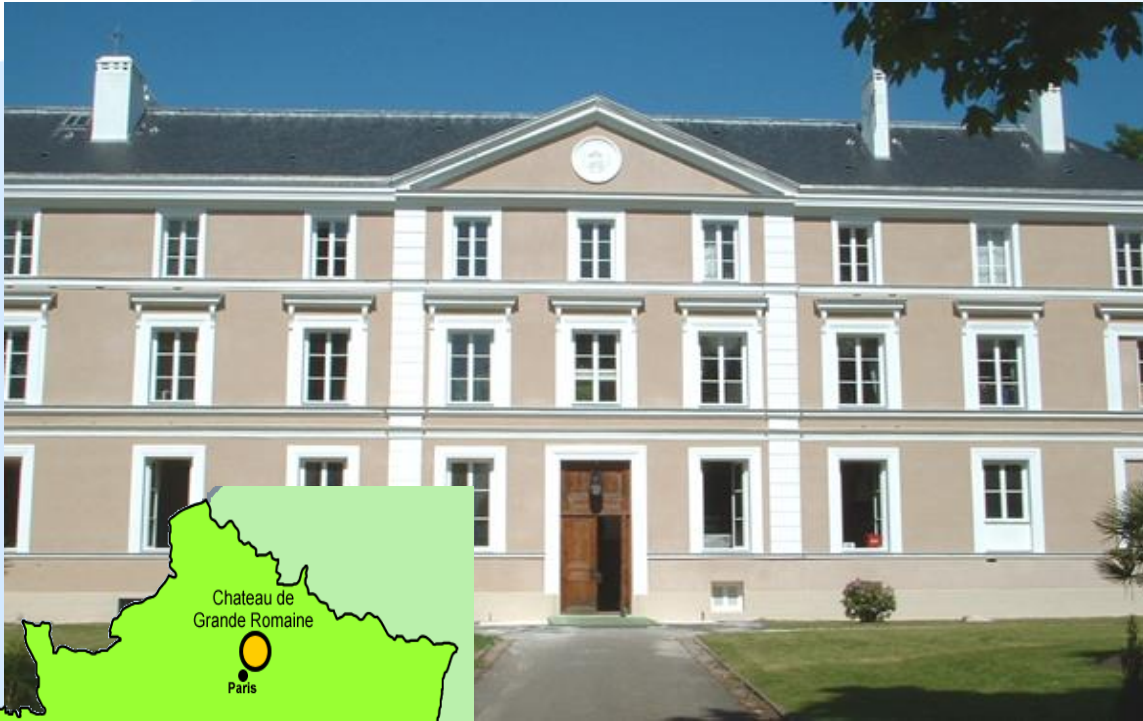
Travel by Coach and Tunnel to arrive in Paris by 6pm.

# Kit List



- All weather comfortable clothes. A coat/ gloves - it can be very cold.

- Hair dryers / Straighteners + adapter plug.
- A Towel
- Small notepad – pen – a watch .
- Medication ( to be handed to group leader before departure- all medication to be clearly labelled in a plastic bag or container, not loose please, with pupil's name, dosage and when required.)
- Pocket Money- in envelopes per day - clearly labelled with amount per day and pupil's name- hand to group leader when on the coach- not in the coach park please. Friday will only have a stop at a service station.
- **Mobile Phones cannot be used for texting / calling home/ calling friends.**
- Book, iPod etc. for the journey- school insurance will not cover the loss of personal items.
